



## Race Fee and Trailering Guidelines

To ensure Race entries are managed and there is no accidental doubling up of boats and adequate space on the trailer race entries are to be entered as below:

Senior/master's	Mike Skoyles Jane Hindmarch (if Mike unavailable)
Juniors	Adam Stancer

Trailering fees are set at £4 per person per regatta/head and should be paid at same time as race entry fee. This fee will be adjusted for crews taking a single boat to an event (ie HERR)

All senior/master's fees will be paid by a nominated person from each crew who will collect the money and deposit it into a dedicated race account (account no and sort code available on request).

When paying into the account please provide a reference of your race entry (event, crew, name etc) to ensure we can see who has paid.

Please ensure when asking for an entry that the money goes into the account, crew entries will not be paid until the money is there and you may miss out on a race if you do not pay. Persons entering crews should not be out of pocket because of poor crew financial management.

Trailer drivers will be paid from the race account on conclusion of the event at a rate of 45p per mile. At the end of the season, any money left over in the race account will go towards the upkeep and maintenance of the trailers.
